

Every day, more than 301 people in the United States die after overdosing on opioids. The misuse of and addiction to opioids—including prescription pain relievers, heroin, and synthetic opioids such as fentanyl—is a serious national crisis.<sup>1</sup> In California there were over 7,100 opioid overdose deaths in 2021, including over 3,900 deaths from fentanyl.

Hospitalization is a “reachable moment” for many people with opioid use disorder (OUD).<sup>3</sup> To accelerate hospital progress in building systems to treat hospitalized patients with OUD and train health care professionals in opioid safety practices, Cal Hospital Compare developed the California Opioid Care Honor Roll Program. The goal of the program is increased access to addiction treatment for hospitalized patients and reduction of opioid-related deaths.

- All California adult, acute care hospitals were invited to participate, and 110 hospitals voluntarily submitted data sharing their progress on implementing evidence-based practices to address the opioid crisis.
- The 110 participating hospitals represent just 1/3 of all adult, acute care hospitals in California, but reflect a diverse cross section of all California hospitals across rural, urban, and academic care settings.
- Participation in the Opioid Care Honor Roll is a signal to California’s healthcare community that all 110 hospitals are actively accelerating and strengthening their opioid stewardship programs.
- Participating hospitals answered eight questions across four key domains of care including safe and effective opioid use, identifying and treating patients with OUD, overdose prevention, and applying cross-cutting opioid management best practices.
- The 2023 Opioid Care Honor roll recognizes four tiers of performance: Superior Performance, Excellent Progress, Most Improved and Sustained Improvement. The methodology is detailed [here](#).
- 42 hospitals achieved ‘Superior Performance,’ with 31 of those hospitals having ‘Sustained’ improvement over the past two years.
- Hospitals achieving ‘Superior Performance’ have implemented advanced, innovative opioid stewardship strategies across multiple service lines, consistently achieving the highest level of performance. In addition, these hospitals are actively measuring and monitoring performance for the purpose of continued quality improvement.
- 35 hospitals achieved ‘Excellent Progress.’ Hospitals achieving ‘Excellent Progress’ have taken steps to spread and scale appropriate opioid prescribing guidelines, OUD treatment, and overdose prevention strategies across one or more service lines that reduce the use and risk of opioids for patients who visit emergency rooms, new patients with pain, and patients being discharged to reduce the likelihood of chronic use.

- 32 hospitals achieved the 'Most Improved' designation. Over the past 12 months, these hospitals have made tremendous progress advancing their opioid stewardship programs in two or more domains of care. This level of progress requires close collaboration between all members of the quality improvement team, and continuous rapid cycle improvement.
- Of the 110 hospitals, 50 of them earned extra credit for providing additional harm reduction services, including but not limited to providing access to low cost or no cost fentanyl test strips and safe injection kits, and information on how to properly store and dispose of opioid medications.
- There is still room for improvement in various areas. These opportunities encompass addressing stigma among physicians and staff, enhancing patient and family engagement, and devising innovative strategies that consider social determinants of health.
- In 2024, Cal Hospital Compare will update the Opioid Management Hospital Self-Assessment with emerging best practices and continue to support their rapid spread among participating hospitals.
