

Mother & Baby Measures Hospitals with Lagged Performance Data

For most of the hospitals listed in the Mother & Baby section on the Cal Hospital Compare website, the results represent **July 2022 – June 2023 performance** for the following measures: NTSV cesarean birth rate, episiotomy rate, VBAC rate, VBAC routinely available, and deliveries by certified nurse midwife. These hospitals submitted data to the California Maternal Quality Care Collaborative (CMQCC) Maternal Data Center cycle reporting and quality improvement.

However, one hospital listed in the Mother & Baby section did not submit data to the CMQCC Maternal Data Center; their results represent Calendar Year 2021 Patient Discharge Data available from the Department of Health Care Access and Information (HCAI) and linked to Birth Certificate Data from the California Department of Public Health-Vital Records by the CMQCC Maternal Data Center. The other nine hospitals have closed.
