

Mother & Baby Measures Hospitals with Lagged Performance Data

For most of the hospitals listed in the Mother & Baby section on the Cal Hospital Compare website, the results represent **July 2023 through June 2024 performance** for 200 hospitals for the following measures: NTSV cesarean birth rate, episiotomy rate, VBAC rate, VBAC routinely available, and deliveries by certified nurse midwife. These hospitals submitted data to the California Maternal Quality Care Collaborative (CMQCC) Maternal Data Center cycle reporting and quality improvement.

However, one hospital listed in the Mother & Baby section did not report data to CMQCC for the full reporting period and the other hospitals have now closed their maternity services and/or on pause. These hospitals are:
